BACKGROUND

For the past three years, Georges River Council has curated the award-nominated, Uncontained Arts Festival, a dynamic 3-night celebration held in Kogarah, NSW. This event is not just a festival; it's a canvas of creativity, bringing together our community in an electrifying atmosphere that fosters unity and contributes to the economic development of our local government area. The festival showcases interactive light installations, live artists, music, sensory exploration, food and family-friendly entertainment in an inclusive and accessible setting.

This event is part of Council's Major Events Program with staff from Community and Culture and City Futures working collaboratively on the development and delivery for many months to provide this unique experience for the community.
