- (a) Claydon Reserve, Ramsgate Road, Sans Souci.
- (b) Claydon Reserve, Torwood Street, Sans Souci.
- (c) Moore Reserve Boat Ramp, Morshead Drive, Hurstville Grove.
- (d) Donnelly Park, Kyle Parade, Connells Point.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1. This report seeks the Council's approval to install '*No Camping or Staying Overnight (vehicles included), penalties may exceed \$1,000 under Section 632 of the Local Government Act 1993*' signage at various locations.

BACKGROUND

2. In 2023, Council officers and the community reported a rise in camping, a form of outdoor recreation involving overnight stays with a tent, in public car parks and open spaces adjacent to the foreshore and beach areas.
3. At this time, Council was notified of camping vehicles being parked incorrectly, tents being placed into adjacent parking spaces, excessive noise being generated at night, littering and public urination.
4. '*No Camping or Staying Overnight (vehicles included), penalties may exceed \$1,000 under Section 632 of the Local Government Act 1993*' signs were generated and placed at the following locations to deter camping vehicles:
 - (a) Sans Souci Park, Rocky Point Road, Sans Souci
 - (b) Dover Park (East), Princes Highway, Blakehurst
 - (c) Carss Bush Park, Bunyala Street, Carss Park
5. Council officers have since received further complaints advising camping vehicles to have relocated to other locations within Georges River LGA adjacent to the foreshore and beach areas.
6. Due to the unrestricted parking arrangements, Council's Compliance team are unable to enforce the parking regulations.
7. Council's Traffic Engineers and Rangers have worked together to proactively identify areas which may attract this activity and look to install further signage to prevent camping and anti-social behaviour that will impact nearby residents.

8. It is proposed to install 'No Camping or Staying Overnight (vehicles included), penalties may exceed \$1,000 under Section 632 of the Local Government Act 1993' signs at the following locations:
 - (a) Claydon Reserve, Ramsgate Road, Sans Souci.
 - (b) Claydon Reserve, Torwood Street, Sans Souci.
 - (c) Moore Reserve Boat Ramp, Morshead Drive, Hurstville Grove.
 - (d) Donnelly Park, Kyle Parade, Connells Point.
9. Images of proposed signage and locations are attached to this report.
10. If Council resolve to install signs at the proposed locations, installation of the new signage will commence in late November 2024, with completion mid-December 2024.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

11. Within budget allocation – TfNSW Traffic Facility Grant – approximately \$3,000.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

12. Community notification will be provided through Council's Social Media Page advising of the signage installation.
